### NHS Action on time critical medication

More than 100 NHS organisations have pledged to improve the delivery of time critical Parkinson's medication. 30% have progressed and are taking action.

### Unlock the value of timely medication: Parkinson's UK time critical medication dashboard

Parkinson's UK commissioned the development of a data dashboard to evaluate the benefits of improving time critical medication management for people with Parkinson's in hospitals. The dashboard will help hospitals in England, Scotland and Wales address the time critical medication issue by estimating the direct cost of delayed or missed medication doses and the impact on patient outcomes.
